GENERAL AUDIENCE June 7, 2017 POPE FRANCIS



Dear Brothers and Sisters:

In our continuing catechesis on Christian hope, we now consider the source of that hope in the fatherhood of God. When the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray, he taught them to call God Our Father. Here we see the great religious revolution introduced by Christianity: taught by the Saviour's command, we dare to speak to the transcendent and all-holy God as children speak, with complete trust, to a loving father. In the parable of the merciful father, who welcomes his prodigal son with supreme forgiveness, Jesus speaks to us of the Father's unconditional love. In his Letters, Saint Paul twice repeats the original Aramaic word used by Jesus in his prayer: "Abba" (cf. Rom 8:15; Gal 4:6). As God's adoptive sons and daughters in the Holy Spirit, we share in the intimate relationship between Jesus and the Father, and this is the basis of our sure hope in God's saving help. Each day, as we pray the Lord's Prayer, may we be confirmed in the knowledge that, in his merciful love, our heavenly Father will watch over us, respond to our petitions, and never abandon us.

St. Anthony of Padua



The feast day of St. Anthony of Padua was on June 13, 2017.

The morning prayer group in devotion to St. Anthony will be providing St. Anthony's bread during the

Saturday June 17, 2017—5 PM Mass. The bread will be Blessed by Father, which then will be distributed after Mass to all parishioners to share.

St. Anthony's Bread is an expression of devotion reminding of St. Anthony's love and aid to the poor when he was alive. The tradition dates back to the 13th century, stemming from a story when a young child fell into a barrel of water and drowned. The mother begged St. Anthony to help, promising to donate grain the weight of her child to the poor if her daughter was restored. The child arose as if asleep. Thus began the tradition of promising and giving alms to the poor for favors received through St. Anthony's intercession.

St. Anthony's Bread is an example of a sacramental of the church, summarized in the Catechism of the Catholic Church: 1677 Sacramentals are sacred signs instituted by the Church. They prepare men to receive the fruit of the sacraments and sanctify different circumstances of life.

The main lesson of St. Anthony's Bread is balancing our prayers. There is intercessory prayers, asking for something, but there needs to be prayers of thanksgiving. St. Anthony of Padua is very generous especially from heaven. He intercedes for us even in seemingly little things to help us. But in turn, he wants us to help our brothers and sisters on earth, especially those less fortunate, with prayers and almsgiving.

Next week we celebrate the feast of the Corpus Christi, which celebrates the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist.
