### Vacation Bible Class, 2017

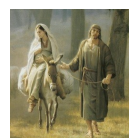

### Fr. Trevor Plug



The diocesan family mourns the loss of a newly ordained priest Fr. Trevor Plug. Trevor was born August 19, 1984 and raised in St. Catharines. He attended Denis Morris High School. Before entering the seminary he did a bachelors degree at the University of Ottawa in linguistics, followed by a Masters degree at King’s College, University of Western Ontario, again in linguistics. The power of words and the Word of God were an idea he carried with him as he discerned a calling to the priesthood. He then went on to St. Peter’s Seminary in London, ON.

He was ordained in 2016 by Bishop Gerard Bergie and was assigned as Associate Pastor at St. Alfred’s Church where he was involved in all aspects of parish life.

Fr. Trevor was an inspiration to all who came into contact with him because he did not allow his disability to define who he was, or what he could accomplish in his life. He is a person worth emulating as we continue on our journey. Fr. Trevor lay in repose at St. Alfred Church June 20th and 21st. His funeral was held on Thursday June 22, 2017 followed by burial at Lakeview Cemetery, Thorold.
