

Life Chain 2018

In a 2 weeks time, pro-lifers will gather at over 200 locations from coast to coast to participate in Life Chain. They will pray silently for an hour while holding nongraphic signs with messages such as, "Abortion kills children," "Abortion hurts women," and "Life: the first inalienable right." Though Life Chain is usually on the first Sunday of October, due to Thanksgiving, it will be held on Sunday, September 30 from 2-3 pm at most Canadian locations this year, including the Lundy's Lane location in Niagara Falls.

Mass with Anointing of the Sick

We will be celebrating Sacrament of the Anointing of the sick with all Masses on Sept.22/23 weekend. Any elderly or seriously ill person can receive this Sacrament. It is one of the 7 Sacraments of the Church, that a person can receive whenever one need it. Please note that it is a Sacrament you are supposed to receive when you are alive and conscious. It is not a death warrant or 'last rite' as many think.

Pope Francis General Audience September 12, 2018

Dear brothers and sisters:

In our catechesis on the Ten Commandments, we have been reflecting on the third commandment: to keep holy the Lord's Day. In the version of the Decalogue found in the Book of Deuteronomy, the command to rest on the Sabbath is linked to the memory of Israel's liberation from the slavery of Egypt. Slaves, as we know, cannot rest. In our own day, so many of our brothers and sisters suffer various forms of enslavement, injustice and inner torment; they long for rest and freedom. Yet, as the example of the martyrs shows us, even in the darkest prisons, it is possible to experience profound interior freedom and repose. True freedom is more than choice. It is liberation from the bondage of selfishness, sin and lovelessness; from such slavery there can be no rest. As Christians, we read, and observe, the third commandment in the light of Christ's coming. By his sacrifice on the Cross, Jesus redeems us from the slavery of sin and enables us to rest in the freedom born of his truth, his mercy and his undying love.

251. How is Christian initiation brought about? 1212 1275

Christian initiation is accomplished by means of the sacraments which establish the foundations of Christian life. The faithful born anew by Baptism are strengthened by Confirmation and are then nourished by the Eucharist.


252. What names are given to the first sacrament of initiation? 1213-1216 1276-1277

This sacrament is primarily called Baptism because of the central rite with which it is celebrated. To baptize means to "immerse" in water. The one who is baptized is immersed into the death of Christ and rises with him as a "new creature" (2 Corinthians 5:17). This sacrament is also called the "bath of regeneration and renewal in the Holy Spirit" (Titus 3:5); and it is called "enlightenment" because the baptized becomes "a son of light" (Ephesians 5:8).
